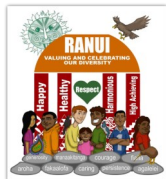

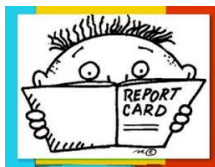
In the last newsletter you will have read about the government providing a donation to schools for each child. We are thinking that this will probably be used for class learning trips,

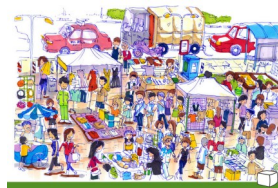

Back on the 19th November Ranui Primary school held their annual middle and senior school athletics day. Great fun was had by all, along with a competitive edge to decide the Ranui Athletics team for 2019. Children competed in 100m, 400m or 800m, High Jump, Long Jump, Shot Put and Discus.



From these events the top 2 children for each age group were chosen to represent our school at the Trust Arena Track on the 26th November. We competed against 14 schools in the Henderson Sports Cluster Athletics day.

The team did extremely well receiving points throughout the day for coming 1st, 2nd or 3rd in each of the Athletic events. Ranui managed to get 380 points this year coming 2nd to a determined Western Heights school with 555 points. We will look forward to trying to win it back off them next year.
