### A WORD FROM OUR PRINCIPAL...

Dear Parent's and Caregivers

Over the past weeks it has been wonderful to see so many of our families engaged with their children's events, as well as going forward, as they navigate their last weeks of Term. Our children, while very excited about the experiences they are having are getting extremely tired. Your help is so appreciated; it enables us to offer opportunities to our children beyond the school gate. It is absolutely wonderful that we are all fully staffed as we head into 2020. We are very fortunate that we have awesome new people to enrich our current team. Our new Deputy Principal Molly Fletcher has been working alongside Team Leaders on the current Curriculum Plan for 2020.

At last night's Board meeting I presented the 2020 Strategic Plan, 2020 Annual Plan and Budget for approval. The focus is on:

- Building an inclusive school culture
- Developing authentic partnerships with our families and whānau
- Culturally responsive teaching and learning
- Building our reputation and confidence as a school of choice for a full primary education

Our key focus areas in 2020 are: Maths; Digital Technologies Curriculum; PB4L sustainability and growth; maximizing out networks within our Community of Learning to support student achievement and developing a Year 1-8 Two-Year curriculum plan.

In addition to our current refurbishment programme we welcomed the announcement by the government this week that we are to receive an additional \$261,261.00 for further refurbishment.

Heads up about Teacher Only Days in 2020: As part of the Teachers recent settlement of their Collective Agreement, they are entitled to a eight Teach Only Release Days over the next two and a half years. Taking these days does not add to the length of the school year. In Term One 2020, out first Teacher Only Day is scheduled for Friday 6th March where we will be analysing our student's achievement data. In Term One I will advise you of the additional two days in the year for Teachers to work on assessment. We are very mindful of the impact the school being closed for instruction will have on many of our families. We will advise our After School Care providers and have attached the days to weekends to try and reduce any inconvenience. Please also note in addition our Kāhui Ako are having a combined Teacher Only Day on the 29th May 2020 where all the schools will come together for a day of professional learning. This is separate to those allocated through the collective.

Ko te ahurei o te tamaiti arahia o tatou mahi. Let the uniqueness of the child guide our work.




